



Consequences of Ragging

All students are expected to maintain decorum within the campus and abide by the college rules and regulations. Acts of misconduct such as ragging, cheating, use of mobile phones during class hours, or damage to college property are strictly prohibited and will invite disciplinary action.

1. Immediate suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Cancellation of admission with no refund of fees.
3. FIR lodged with local police authorities under anti-ragging law.
4. Debarring from appearing in any university or college examination.
5. Withholding or cancellation of degree/certificates issued by the institution.
6. Expulsion from the hostel and permanent disqualification from hostel admission.
7. Heavy monetary fines and compensation for any damages caused.
8. Disqualification from campus placements and professional recommendations.
9. Public disclosure of misconduct to deter future violations.
10. Legal action under Indian Penal Code (IPC) sections dealing with harassment and abuse.
